1) 2009 Aerials

The aerial was flown on April 16th and 17th. The weather was excellent.
The Lidar flight was flown by the state during the same period.
We are expecting the pilot project to be delivered in mid July.

The pilot project is the three sections just north of Oregon. This area has most of the typical land types in the county. (Hills, Flat lands, Rivers and Urban area)

2) Beacon Website

The website has been running with very little problems. It was mentioned that the road right of way feature disappeared. We will look into restoring this feature.

3) Booklets

The Ogle County Road Booklet has been updated for 2009
We now have the Ogle County Address Booklet available. The address booklet contains only the rural addresses. Due to scale issues, the urban addresses are not shown.
