• Project Status:

- 1) 2009 Aerials
Final payment made. Project complete.
- 2) Sign Program
An intern for the Highway Department has finished collecting gps locations and condition of signs on all of the County/ Township / Municipalities maintained roads. We are now mapping out the data was collected..

- 3) The Bike Path projects and the Byron Marina project are still progressing. There hasn't been much activity in the past month, though.
- 4) Mitigation Plan
Maps have been provided to the consultants for this project. So far, we have provided tornado touchdown and path locations as well as critical facilities, flood plains, buildings in the flood plains, and critical infrastructure.
- 5) Collaboration
Lee County E911 has given us a list of their fire/ambulance/police boundaries along with addresses for our use. Five of our Fire Districts run into Lee County. Having the data to give to our Districts will help them perform their duties more quickly and efficiently
- 6) Grants via OCEMA
Working with the Ogle County Emergency Management Agency has opened access to new funding grants. Through our on-going work with the County Mitigation Plan; we have shown the need of involving GIS in local/state/federal emergency management. We have received a grant to purchase two extension to for our current ArcGIS software.
- 7) GPS Projects
We are collecting utility information for the Village of Creston.
